LOCATION: Mohegan Sun is located on 185 acres along the banks of the Thames River in the town of Uncasville, Connecticut. It is approximately one mile from the interchange of I-395 and Conn. Rte. 2A, in the heart of the scenic foothills of southeastern Connecticut, where 60 percent of state tourism is concentrated. It is within easy access of New York, Boston, Hartford and Providence and located 15 minutes from the museums, antique shops and waterfront of Mystic Country.

DESCRIPTION: Mohegan Sun, owned by the Mohegan Tribe, is the premier gaming, entertainment, meeting, dining and shopping destination on the East Coast. Since it was unveiled in 1996, Mohegan Sun has continued to evolve and today features:

- Over 250,000 square feet of gaming space, including smoke-free areas
- Nearly 6,000 slot machines
- More than 350 table games

- More than 30 retail shops
- A 1,200-room luxury hotel tower
- A 20,000 square-foot, world-class Elemis Spa
- Over 45 restaurants and food and beverage outlets including bars and lounges
- Three entertainment venues including a 10,000-seat Arena; a 350-seat Cabaret Theatre and a 300-seat Wolf Den
- More than 100,000 square feet of meeting and function space, including the 38,000 square-foot Uncas Ballroom
- A professionally-managed business center
- 10,000 square-foot indoor pool
- A 17,500 square-foot outdoor sun terrace
- Mohegan Sun Mobil Gas Station & Convenience Store, which features twenty full-service and self-serve islands

DESIGNERS:

Mohegan Sun's extraordinary Tribal-inspired designs are the result of a unique collaborative effort by several of the world's most renowned architectural and design firms. Kohn Pedersen Fox Associates designed Mohegan Sun's dramatic, yet understated exterior and luxury hotel tower, while Rockwell Group created Mohegan-inspired designs for the gaming space, retail and restaurant promenade and hotel lobby. Hirsch Bedner Associates designed the plush 1,200-room, 34-story luxury hotel interiors and meeting spaces.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Mohegan Sun's 34-story hotel tower is one of the tallest buildings in Connecticut and features 1,200 luxurious guest rooms – including over 170 suites – with a minimum of 450 square feet per room. Each room features:

- A luxurious bathroom
- Three two-line telephones with dataports
- Voice mail
- Full-size working desk area with ergonomic chair
- Oversized lounging chair with ottoman
- Deluxe bedding and linens
- In-room safe
- In-room refreshment and entertainment center, including 27" television with movies and video games on demand, web and email access, video in-room dining menus and ordering, bill review and check-out accessibility
- State-of-the-art electronic security entry system
- Individually controlled heating and air-conditioning
- Clock-radio
- In-room irons and full-size ironing boards
- Hair dryers

GOLF: Purchased in May of 2007 and renamed Mohegan Sun Country Club at Pautipaug, this 18-hole private golf course is recognized statewide for its impeccable greens and lavish fairways. It underwent major renovations in 2011 that included reconfigured holes, several new greens and an additional 125 yards of length across the course. Amenities at the course include:

- Driving range & practice putting greens

MEETING FACILITIES:

Mohegan Sun is the venue of choice for East Coast meetings and conventions, providing:

- 100,000 square feet of flexible meeting and function space
- The 38,000 square-foot Uncas Ballroom, which is divisible into 10 separate meeting rooms
- More than 30 conference and breakout rooms, accommodating up to 5,300 people
- More than 14,000 square feet of pre-function space adjacent to the grand ballroom
- A 17,500 square-foot sun terrace for outdoor functions
- A 10,000-seat Arena featuring 30,000 square feet of exhibition space
- On-site, state-of-the-art audiovisual technology and professional staff
- Expertly trained convention services and catering staff
- A professionally managed business center, featuring individual work stations with Internet access, printers, copiers, shipping services and the latest business and productivity software
- Two group registration desks, offices and storage areas

GAMING:

Mohegan Sun's over 350,000 square feet of gaming space makes it one of the largest gaming complexes in the world. Exciting games of chance and skill can be found in an exciting environment that pays tribute to the Mohegan past. Three gaming venues found within Mohegan Sun include:

Casino of the Earth: At nearly 180,000 square feet, Mohegan Sun's Casino of the Earth was unveiled in 1996. Its rich environment highlights the Mohegan culture and the importance of the four seasons in the Mohegan cycle of life. It features more than 3,700 slot machines; nearly 200 gaming tables, including such perennial favorites as blackjack, craps, roulette, pai gow poker, Caribbean stud poker, Keno and baccarat. For the comfort of non-smoking patrons, Casino of the Earth includes the Hall of The Lost Tribes, a fully enclosed smoke-free slot room with more than 600 slot machines. It also includes a full-service food and beverage concession including a cocktail bar featuring video poker.

In August 2007, Mohegan Sun unveiled Sunrise Square, located in Casino of the Earth, adjacent to the Race Book. The area includes a 4,000 square-foot authentic Southeast Asian cuisine food court, new bus lobby, retail outlet and redesigned gaming space with nearly 100 slot machines and over 40 table games.

Casino of the Sky: Unveiled in September 2001, the addition of the 119,000 square-foot Casino of the Sky made Mohegan Sun one of the largest gaming complexes in the world. Its show-stopping design elements include the world's largest, fully functional planetarium dome, providing ever-changing cosmic displays, and a dramatic, multi-level onyx and alabaster structure called Wombi Rock, which houses a lounge and a dance floor. Gaming enthusiasts can find over 2,200 slot machines and over 100 table games, a 3,000 square-foot high-limit lounge and special non-smoking gaming area located underneath a giant turtle shell showcasing the Sky.

Casino of the Wind: Opening in 2008, Casino of the Wind is home 45,000 square feet of gaming space including a 42-table poker room, over 25 additional traditional table games and over 700 slot machines. Casino of the Wind also includes a 16,000 square-foot Jimmy Buffett's Margaritaville and the quick-service Chief's Deli.

Race Book: Mohegan Sun's full-service Race Book is a one-of-a-kind facility that offers state-of-the-art viewing of live horse and greyhound racing events as well as professional Jai Alai. It is the only New England off-track wagering facility to cover the New York Racing Association Circuit (Belmont, Aqueduct and Saratoga) and Jai Alai. The Race Book is equipped with over 300 television screens and over 200 self-wagering carrels to bring the race to the guests.

ENTERTAINMENT:

Mohegan Sun radiates excitement every night as celebrated stars light up its stages with electrifying performances.

The 10,000-seat Mohegan Sun Arena hosts major national acts, world championship boxing and much more. Home to the WNBA's Connecticut Sun.

The 350-seat Cabaret Theatre showcases dynamic and intimate entertainment such as acoustic concerts and comedy shows.

The 300-seat Wolf Den is a centerpiece to Casino of the Earth, offering free nightly entertainment for guests 21 and over, with no cover charge and no minimum.

NIGHTLIFE:

The nightlife scene at Mohegan Sun has evolved into a collection of incredible nightclubs, bars and lounges, including The Lansdowne Irish Pub & Music House, Ballo Social Club, Vista Lounge and MIST. Mohegan Sun Nightlife is an unmatched destination for evening of great entertainment in Connecticut. Private functions and/or VIP seating is available in each of the attractions. The Lansdowne Irish Pub & Music House brings a touch of Gaelic flair and the utmost in Irish hospitality to Mohegan Sun. Guests can gather and relax, celebrate and bond over a bite to eat, pint or song. Ballo Social Club, located in Casino of the Earth, brings sophistication and Italian nightlife to the forefront. The stylish lounge is straight out of Tuscany, where top DJs set the mood under chic antique lighting. Vista Lounge at Wombi Rock is a true ultra lounge, equipped with plush coves, VIP sections, an intimate dance floor and a state-of-the-art 60,000 watt sound system. And finally – MIST is a new, contemporary styled club located in front of the ever-changing multimedia 3-story water wall in Casino of the Wind. It's the most unique nightlife experiences Mohegan Sun offers with an industrial chic design, eye dazzling metallic furniture and great drink specials.

CHILDREN'S FACILITIES:

For guests with children, Mohegan Sun features Kids Quest/Cyber Quest family entertainment complex, just steps from The Shops at Mohegan Sun retail promenade. Staffed

by licensed professionals who are trained in first aid and CPR, Kids Quest is geared for children six weeks to twelve years old and also features a non-violent video arcade and the new Family Adventure Club where parents can join their children for some quality family fun. The Family Adventure Club is available prior to the opening of Kids Quest each day and features activities such as karaoke, basketball and arcade & video games.

PARKING:

The casino's parking facilities accommodate approximately 13,000 cars and includes valet service and indoor and outdoor parking options.

EMPLOYMENT:

Since opening in October 1996, Mohegan Sun has earned a reputation as one of the premier employers in the region. The company provides employees with medical, dental, vision and prescription drug coverage; life insurance and optional supplemental life insurance; a 401(k), and excellent free meals. Mohegan Sun offers healthcare benefits to domestic partners and dependents. Employees park on-site at the \$29 million state-of-the-art Eagleview Employee Center that includes fitness, wellness and computer centers, a bank, dry cleaner, employee pharmacy and more.

ACCESS:

Mohegan Sun is conveniently located approximately one mile from the interchange of Interstate 395 and Connecticut Route 2A, just outside of Montville in southeastern Connecticut. Mohegan Sun's four-lane access road, Mohegan Sun Boulevard, has its own exit leading to and from Route 2A (Exit 2) and gives casino patrons direct access to Interstate 395 and Interstate 95, the main highways connecting New York, Bridgeport, New Haven, Providence and Boston. The access road also alleviates any added traffic congestion on local Montville roads.
