



Mohegan Sun Golf Club Offers Guests Another Way to Stay & Play

Mohegan Sun Golf Club is an 18-hole championship golf course that gives Mohegan Sun guests an opportunity to play on one of the most beautiful golf courses in southeastern Connecticut. The Mohegan Tribal Gaming Authority (MTGA), the operators of Mohegan Sun, acquired Pautipaug Country Club in Franklin, Connecticut in June of 2007. The golf course, now known as Mohegan Sun Golf Club, is a short drive from the main property in Uncasville, CT and is open to all resort and public play.

The course is recognized in the region and beyond for its impeccable playing conditions that gently roll through the scenic hills of southeastern Connecticut, the course was originally designed by the late architect, Geoffrey Cornish. Who is now remembered as one of the most renowned and prolific golf course designers of our time.

In 2012, Mohegan Sun made major enhancements to the course which included the re-design of 6 holes, all-new greens and fairways and newly-renovated clubhouse. Further updates in the 2016 off-season have included a redesign of the third hole green complex, a new golf fitness room, FlightScope training technology, a new club repair shop, all-new high-end GPS enabled golf carts and a completely remodeled Golf Shop.
