

OVERVIEW

What began with the 1996 opening of Casino of the Earth has evolved into the East Coast's premier entertainment, meeting, shopping and gaming destination.

Today more than 25,000 daily visitors test their luck and skill at Mohegan Sun's two unique casinos, shop and dine at more than 70 dining and premium retail outlets and experience award-winning entertainment at three world-class venues. There are two luxurious hotel towers, including the 1,200-room Sky Tower at Mohegan Sun, complete with 275,000 square feet of flexible meeting space.

Mohegan Sun has also embarked on multiple high-profile expansions in its history, and is now a 3.5 million square-foot property as well as the highest grossing casino in the Northeast.

Mohegan Sun Property Overview

Mohegan Sun's Casino of the Earth and Casino of the Sky feature world-class entertainment, meeting, shopping, gaming and dining facilities. With more than 255,000 square feet of gaming which includes more than 300 table games, a 33-table Poker Room and over 4,000 slots. With the addition of the \$80 million Earth Expo & Convention Center that opened in spring 2018, Mohegan Sun also is now home to 275,000 square feet of flexible meeting and event space to join nearly 1,600 deluxe hotel rooms, a 10,000-seat award-winning entertainment venue and 135,000 square feet of shopping. Below is a complete breakdown of all our offerings.

Mohegan Sun's **Casino of the Earth** is comprised of nearly 180,000 square feet of gaming space and features more than 1,900 slot machines, a 33-table Poker Room,

a non-smoking slot hall and more than 200 gaming tables that include such perennial favorites as Blackjack, Craps, Roulette, Caribbean Stud Poker and Baccarat. Also inside Casino of the Earth is Mohegan Sun's Race Book, which offers live racing from New York (Belmont, Aqueduct and Saratoga).

With rousing games of skill and chance, **Casino of the Sky** includes 119,000 square feet of gaming and features over 90 gaming tables, more than 1,800 slots, a high-limit lounge and two special non-smoking gaming areas. It also features the world's largest, fully functional indoor planetarium dome, inside VISTA Lounge at Wombi Rock, which sits in the middle of Casino of the Sky and also features Blackjack tables. Just one of the show-stopping elements of Mohegan Sun, the planetarium features ever-changing fiber-optic displays of the sun, moon and stars and is accompanied by the lighting effects of Wombi Rock, a multi-level onyx and alabaster entertainment and lounge venue.

Mohegan Sun is the premier destination for meetings and conventions on the East Coast. Corporate functions, trade shows and exhibits are common commodities in Mohegan Sun's Sky Convention Center and Earth Expo & Convention Center. There is 275,000 square feet of flexible meeting and function space at Mohegan Sun, including the 125,000 square-foot Earth Expo Center and the 38,000 square-foot Uncas Ballroom. The 10,000-seat Mohegan Sun Arena (featuring 30,000 square feet of exhibition space), can also be used for various events, in addition to the 120 plus concerts and sporting events it features yearly.

Rest and relaxation can be found within Mohegan Sun's two tower hotel featuring 1,564 spacious and elegantly appointed guest rooms, over 200 suites and the 16,000 square-foot Mandara Spa at Mohegan Sun.

Dining

Mohegan Sun is pulling out all the stops to deliver incomparable gaming,

entertainment and dining experiences. With a wide variety of dining choices comprising more than 3,000 seats, every culinary expectation is exceeded at Mohegan Sun. Whether it's a delicious Italian feast at Todd English's Tuscany or a gourmet meal prepared at Bobby Flay's Bar Americain, Michael Jordan's Steak House or Jasper White's Summer Shack, nothing is left to chance.

Guaranteed crowd pleasers also include BALLO Italian Restaurant, Seasons Buffet, The Lansdowne Irish Pub & Music House, Tom's Urban and Phantasia at Sunrise Square. Rounding out the food and beverage options are choices that have won rave reviews elsewhere in the country including Johnny Rockets, Chick-fil-A, Ben & Jerry's, Bobby's Burger Palace, Carlo's Bakery, Frank Pepe Pizzeria Napoletana, Jersey Mike's Subs and Starbucks. In total, there are 40 dining options across Mohegan Sun.

Located in the Race Book, the New Belgium Brewing Taproom brings the ultimate brew selection to Mohegan Sun, featuring a rotating line of sour and seasonal beers and occasionally showcasing limited and special release beers.

Entertainment

Mohegan Sun's 10,000-seat Arena and 350-seat Wolf Den are home to electrifying performances and legendary events. Legendary acts from almost every musical genre such as Salt-N-Pepa, America, Lupe Fiasco, Eddie Money, Slash, LL Cool J, Uncle Kracker and Warrant have performed in the Wolf Den, all at no cover charge and no minimum.

Avalon Nightclub, owned by the Lyons Group, offers world-class DJs along with a state-of-the-art sound and lighting system. The Lansdowne Irish Pub & Music House brings a touch of Gaelic flair and the utmost in Irish hospitality to Mohegan Sun. Guests can gather and relax, celebrate and bond over a bite to eat, pint or song. Luxury Hotels

When a day of excitement is complete, guests will find soothing repose at Mohegan Sun's 1,200-room luxury Sky Tower, which was unveiled in April 2002. The 30,000 square-foot lobby, designed by Rockwell Group, sets a dramatic albeit peaceful scene that includes a simulated cedar forest. Here water gurgles playfully in reflecting pools and light dances through canopies of beaded crystalline leaves on trees that reach toward luminous sky lights.

Mohegan Sun's spacious guest rooms – including roughly 200 suites – feature a minimum of 450 square feet per room. Each provides luxurious bathrooms, deluxe bedding and linens, three two-line telephones with data ports, a full-size working desk area with an ergonomic chair and more.

At the highest reaches of Sky Tower, floors 31-36, is a luxury hotel experience known as *Aspire*. The high-roller treatment begins and ends with first-class personalized service (including a butler), from arrival to departure. *Aspire* guests also get access to *Thirty Three*, a luxury food and beverage experience on the 33rd floor that showcases modern designs, a sky-high view of the southern New England hills, complimentary cocktails, beer, dining options and blackjack and roulette tables.

Creating even more ways to stay and play, Mohegan Sun unveiled the all-new Earth Tower in 2016. The 242,000 square-foot Earth Tower features 400 additional well-appointed guest rooms, including 39 suites, in addition to the spacious and elegant appointed room and suites in Mohegan Sun's deluxe Sky Tower. Each room and suite is also home to advance in-room technology, including ultra-fast Wi-Fi, intelligent thermostats and dual-line telephones. Other amenities include a Mandara Spa, fitness center and pool.

The Earth Tower lobby is home to various lounging areas along with Bean and Vine Café & Wine Bar, where guests can grab breakfast and a coffee in the morning, and relax with friends over a glass of wine or beer in the evening. Just outside Bean and Vine is the Earth Tower Terrace, featuring gas fire pits and a satellite bar & food service. The space can also be utilized for private functions as well, including wedding receptions, anniversaries and more.

Mandara Spa

Located in both Sky Tower and Earth Tower, Mandara Spa at Mohegan Sun provides the most unique and indulgent spa treatments. Whether it's in the 16,000 square foot Spa in Sky Tower or the 2,800 square-foot boutique healing house on the lobby level of Earth Tower, incredible massage and facial therapies await.

The Sky Tower Mandara Spa is located on the third floor near the Sun Terrace Pool and remodeled Fitness Center, and is home to 13-treatment rooms featuring two couples' suites, eight single massage rooms, three esthetic rooms, calming lounges, locker rooms with amenities (sauna, steam room and hydro pool), a spa reception with retail area and a full service salon.

The boutique healing house in Earth Tower is a seven-room refuge, which features a couple's suite, six dual-use rooms, a waiting lounge and retail area. Spa therapies include signature treatments such as the Mandara Customized Massage, Mandara Signature Facial and the Fire & Ice Massage.

Meeting Space & Conventions

Mohegan Sun also features a 38,000 square-foot Uncas Ballroom, a 20,000 square-foot Earth Ballroom, a 125,000 square-foot Earth Expo Center and in total, more than 275,000 square feet of high-tech and flexible meeting and function space. There are now more than 45 conference and breakout rooms, with two beautiful and high-tech executive boardrooms, the latest addition being the Wolf Boardroom, which also has its own outdoor terrace area.

An advisory board of meeting and event planners from nationally-recognized associations, companies and suppliers has made certain that every facility design and product development fulfills the most taxing demands of today's growing meetings and conventions industry.

As a result, gatherings at Mohegan Sun are an experience without rival anywhere on the East Coast. Meeting attendees from all over the nation find that coming together at this world-class destination is comparable to entering into an exclusive new world, where the best of entertainment, dining and adventure is available under one roof.

Golf

Mohegan Sun Golf Club (MSGC) is an 18-hole Championship Golf Course that invites Mohegan Sun guests to play on one of the truly hidden gems of southeastern Connecticut. Mohegan Gaming & Entertainment (MGE) the operators of Mohegan Sun, purchased Pautipaug Country Club in Baltic, Connecticut in May of 2007. It was renamed Mohegan Sun Country Club at Pautipaug and reopened as a private facility for members, casino and hotel guests and convention goers. In 2012, Mohegan Sun made major enhancements to the course which included the re-design of six holes, all-new greens and fairways and newly-renovated clubhouse. It has recently been renamed to Mohegan Sun Golf Club and has had further significant upgrades in recent years.
