Mohegan Sun Golf Club Offers Guests Another Way to Stay & Play

Mohegan Sun Golf Club (MSGC), a 156-acre 72-par course, is one of the premier golf destinations in the Northeast. The Mohegan Tribal Gaming Authority (MTGA), now known as Mohegan Gaming & Entertainment (MGE), who operate Mohegan Sun, acquired Pautipaug Country Club in Baltic, Connecticut in June of 2007. The golf course, now titled Mohegan Sun Golf Club, is a short drive from the main property in Uncasville, CT and is open to resort and public play.

The course is recognized in the region and beyond for its impeccable playing conditions that gently roll through the scenic hills of southeastern Connecticut. Originally designed by the late and legendary architect, Geoffrey Cornish, MGE has made significant enhancements throughout the course, clubhouse and practice areas.

The 18-Hole Championship Golf Course was named to *Golfweek's* "Top 50 Casino Golf Courses" in 2018, and receives similar acclaim in several publications. Roughly a 20-minute drive from Mohegan Sun, the course is nestled in a scenic New England landscape and home to a beautiful, multi-purpose clubhouse and the recently updated restaurant, Pautipaug Pub & Grille. MSGC's clubhouse, stretching 20,000 square feet in total, also features a second floor banquet room that can be customized for a broad range of private parties and group events.

High-profile tournaments, often open to the public, regularly take place at Mohegan Sun Golf Club and over the years have played host to Michael Jordan, Bill Murray, Joe Pesci, Aaron Rodgers, Chris Paul, Larry Fitzgerald, Ahmad Rashad, Marcus Allen, Charles Barkley and many more.
