LOCATION: Mohegan Sun is located on 185 acres along the banks of the Thames River in the town of Uncasville, Connecticut. It is approximately one mile from the interchange of I-395 and Connecticut Route 2A, in the heart of the scenic foothills of southeastern Connecticut, where 60 percent of state tourism is concentrated. It is within easy access of New York, Boston, Hartford and Providence and located 15 minutes from the museums, antique shops and waterfront of Mystic Country.

DESCRIPTION: Mohegan Sun, owned by Mohegan, is the premier gaming, entertainment, meeting, dining and shopping destination on the East Coast. Since it was unveiled in 1996, Mohegan Sun has continued to evolve and today features:

- More than 260,000 square feet of gaming space
- Nearly 4,000 slot machines
- More than 300 table games
- A 33-table Poker Room in Casino of the Earth

- More than 30 retail shops
- A two-tower luxury hotel featuring 1,600 guest rooms and more than 200 suites
- Two world-class spas
- More than 40 restaurants and food and beverage outlets including bars, lounges and nightlife venues
- Multiple entertainment venues including a 10,000-seat Arena and a 350-seat Wolf Den
- 275,000 square feet of meetings, expo & function space, including the 36,500 square-foot Uncas Ballroom and the 20,000 square-foot Earth Ballroom.
- A professionally managed business center
- 10,000 square-foot solarium, including an indoor/outdoor pool
- A 17,500 square-foot outdoor sun terrace
- Mohegan Sun Mobil Gas Station & Convenience Store, which features twenty full-service and self-serve islands

DESIGNERS:

Mohegan Sun's extraordinary Tribal-inspired designs are the result of a unique collaborative effort by several of the world's most renowned architectural and design firms. Kohn Pedersen Fox Associates designed Mohegan Sun's dramatic, yet understated exterior and luxury hotel Sky Tower, while Rockwell Group created Mohegan-inspired designs for the gaming space, retail and restaurant promenade and hotel lobby. Hirsch Bedner Associates designed the plush 1,200-room, 34-story luxury Sky Tower hotel interiors and meeting spaces.

- A second hotel tower, Earth Tower, checking in at 400 beautifully appointed rooms.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Mohegan Sun's Sky Tower is one of the tallest buildings in Connecticut and includes 1,200 spacious and elegantly appointed guest rooms more than 170 suites – with a minimum of 450 square feet per room, and high-end suites surpassing 3,000 square-feet. Each room features:

- A luxurious bathroom
- Three two-line telephones with dataports
- Full-size working desk area with ergonomic chair
- Oversized lounging chair with ottoman
- Deluxe bedding and linens
- In-room safe
- In-room refreshment and entertainment center, including 27" television with movies and video games on demand, web and email access, video in-room dining menus and ordering, bill review and check-out accessibility
- State-of-the-art electronic security entry system
- Individually controlled heating and air-conditioning
- Clock-radio
- In-room irons and full-size ironing boards
- Hair dryers

Not to be outdone, Mohegan Sun opened a second hotel tower, the 400-room Earth Tower, in 2016. The lobby is home to various lounging areas along with Bean and Vine Café & Wine Bar, where guests can grab breakfast and a coffee in the morning and relax with friends over a glass of wine or beer in the evening, all with a beautiful view. Located on the ground level, in front of the Tower, the outdoor Earth

Tower Terrace features gas fire pits and bar & food service, when weather permits. The space can also be utilized for private functions, including wedding receptions, anniversaries and more. Other amenities in Earth Tower include:

GOLF:

Purchased in May of 2007, the 18-hole private golf course, Mohegan Sun Golf Club (MSGC), is recognized statewide for its impeccable greens and lavish fairways. It underwent major renovations in 2011 that included reconfigured holes, several new greens and an additional 125 yards of length across the course. In the 2016 off-season further updates included a redesign of the third hole green complex, a new golf fitness room, incorporation of FlightScope training technology, a new club repair shop, all-new high-end GPS enabled golf carts and a newly remodeled Golf Shop. Mohegan Sun Golf Club is also home to a very spacious banquet facility, ready to host a variety of private parties, group golf outings, corporate events and weddings. A driving range and practice greens are also featured at Mohegan Sun Golf Club. MSGC also offers a Golf Academy, helmed by Head Golf Pro, Joe Mentz and provides members swing lessons, custom club fittings, group sessions, beneficial skills challenges all in a personalized instructional setting.

MEETING FACILITIES:

Mohegan Sun is the venue of choice for East Coast meetings and conventions, providing:

- 275,000 square feet of flexible meeting and function space across two incredible convention centers, Earth Expo & Convention Center and Sky Convention Center
- An Expo Center (Earth Expo) that's column-free and 125,000 square-feet (equivalent to four NFL fields)
- The 36,500-square-foot Uncas Ballroom, which is divisible into 10 separate meeting rooms
- More than 40 conference and breakout rooms, accommodating up to 5,300 people
- More than 20,000 square feet of pre-function space between both Sky Convention Center and Earth Expo & Convention Center
- A state-of-the-art 1,200 square-foot Executive Boardroom with its own pre-function room + outdoor terrace, entitled Wolf Boardroom
- A 17,500 square-foot sun terrace for outdoor functions with 11,300 square feet of meeting and event space
- A 10,000-seat Arena featuring 30,000 square feet of exhibition space
- On-site, state-of-the-art audiovisual technology and professional staff
- Expertly trained convention services and catering staff
- A professionally managed business center, featuring individual workstations with Internet access, printers, copiers, shipping services and the latest business and productivity software
- Multiple group registration desks, offices and storage areas

GAMING:

Mohegan Sun's more than 260,000 square feet of gaming space makes it one of the largest gaming complexes in the world. Exciting games of chance and skill can be found in a thrilling environment that pays tribute to the Mohegan past. Three gaming venues found within Mohegan Sun include:

Casino of the Earth: At nearly 180,000 square feet, Mohegan Sun's Casino of the Earth was unveiled in 1996. Its rich environment highlights the Mohegan culture and the importance of the four seasons in the Mohegan cycle of life. It features over 2,000 slot machines and over 160 table games. It also includes various casino bars that feature video poker.

In August 2007, Mohegan Sun unveiled Sunrise Square, located in Casino of the Earth, which is now adjacent to the Sportsbook. The area includes a 4,000 square-foot authentic Southeast Asian cuisine food court, new bus lobby, retail outlet and redesigned gaming space.

Casino of the Sky: Unveiled in September 2001, the addition of the 119,000 square-foot Casino of the Sky made Mohegan Sun one of the largest gaming complexes in the world. Its show-stopping design elements include the world's largest, fully functional planetarium dome, providing ever-changing cosmic displays, and a dramatic, multi-level onyx and alabaster structure called Wombi Rock, which houses a lounge and a dance floor. Gaming enthusiasts can find nearly 1,900 slot machines and over 90 table games, a 3,000 square-foot high-limit lounge and a special non-smoking gaming area located underneath a giant turtle shell showcasing the Sky.

Mohegan Sun FanDuel Sportsbook: Mohegan Sun is home to a massive FanDuel Sportsbook that sports the largest video wall on the East Coast at 140-feet wide. The Mohegan Sun FanDuel Sportsbook is also home to a full dining menu, cocktails and draft beer, 39 betting kiosks, six cashier windows, a mezzanine level available for private parties and much more. In September of 2022, Mohegan Sun FanDuel Sportsbook hosted Rob Gronkowski's Official Retirement Party, which was sold out.

ENTERTAINMENT:

Mohegan Sun radiates excitement every night as celebrated stars light up its stages with electrifying performances.

The 10,000-seat Mohegan Sun Arena hosts major national acts, world championship boxing and much more. It currently averages around 120 events per year, which accounts for 700,000 visitors annually. Mohegan Sun Arena is also home to the WNBA's Connecticut Sun.

The legendary 350-seat Wolf Den is a centerpiece to Casino of the Earth, offering free nightly entertainment for guests 21 and over, with no cover charge and no minimum. The Wolf Den has hosted the likes of Bret Michaels, Dustin Lynch, Ludacris, The Marshall Tucker Band, Sister Hazel, Chubby Checker, Warrant, Queensrÿche, LL Cool J and many more.

Comix Comedy Club, as part of Comix Roadhouse, is a 400-seat independently owned and operated comedy club and craft beer bar located in Casino of the Earth. Open every Thursday through Sunday and serving happy hour from 4:00pm-6:00pm, Comix Comedy Club showcases national

headliners, superb regional and local talent and off-beat shows; all on a stage built for comedy.

The 400-seat Cabaret Theatre showcases dynamic and intimate entertainment such as acoustic concerts and comedy shows.

NIGHTLIFE:

The nightlife scene at Mohegan Sun has evolved into a collection of incredible nightclubs, bars and lounges, including Avalon Nightclub, novelle, The Lansdowne Irish Pub & Music House, Comix Roadhouse and VISTA Lounge at Wombi Rock. Mohegan Sun nightlife is an unmatched destination for an evening of great entertainment in Connecticut. Private functions and/or VIP seating is available in each of the attractions.

Avalon Nightclub, Mohegan Sun's popular nightclub, offers world-class DJs along with state-of-the-art sound and lighting systems.

The Lansdowne Irish Pub & Music House brings a touch of Gaelic flair and the utmost in Irish hospitality to Mohegan Sun. Guests can gather and relax, celebrate and bond over a bite to eat, pint or song.

VISTA Lounge at Wombi Rock is a true ultra lounge, equipped with plush coves, VIP sections, an intimate dance floor and a state-of-the-art 60,000 watt sound system.

Clay Pipe Cigar Bar is a unique and sophisticated venue located in Casino of the Sky, open evenings through late night from Monday through Friday and afternoon through

late night on Saturday and Sunday. Guests can sip craft cocktails and enjoy over 200 fine cigars including top-notch options from Marcudao.

And novelle, launched in the late spring of 2019, is a unique experience that shifts seamlessly from chic cocktail lounge to thrilling table games to eclectic eats to upbeat nightlife.

ACCESS:

Mohegan Sun is conveniently located approximately one mile from the interchange of Interstate 395 and Connecticut Route 2A, just outside of Montville in southeastern Connecticut. Mohegan Sun's four-lane access road, Mohegan Sun Boulevard, has its own exit leading to and from Route 2A and gives casino patrons direct access to Interstate 395 and Interstate 95, the main highways connecting New York, Bridgeport, New Haven, Providence and Boston. The access road also alleviates any added traffic congestion on local Montville roads.
